Notice on Transfer from Other Majors
(Starting 1 June 2026)

Students who would like to transfer to the IE/MIE Major must satisfy at least one of the following minimum conditions:

- (a) Completed at least 6 units of courses with an average grade of not less than B- that would count towards the major requirements of the transfer-in programme; or
- (b) the admission WGPA score (e.g. HKDSE) higher than that of students in the lowest decile admitted to the programme in the same year as their first admission to the University; or
- (c) attained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above in the current academic year.

(1) For students to be transferred

Submit an e-Application form(s) via the CUSIS from 1 June to 26 June 2026 together with a letter stating reason(s) for transfer, an unofficial transcript and a copy of the HKDSE/ Gaokao result.

The Department will inform applicants of the decision via the CUSIS during 29 June to 6 July 2026. Students are required to confirm their acceptance of the NEW major (for approval cases) from 7 July to 13 July 2026.

For successful applications, students will receive a formal approval letter from Registration and Examinations Section (RES) confirming the change of major by late July 2026.

(2) For students admitted under broad-based programmes

Student has to obtain a hardcopy application form at RES counter or by sending an email request to ugadmin@cuhk.edu.hk, and submit the application form together with a letter stating reason(s) for transfer, an unofficial transcript, a copy of HKDSE result to the Department by 26 June 2026. **Please note that your application will be processed only after you have declared a major programme.**

The Department will notify students of the result of their applications on 3 July by phone/email. Successful applicants should come to the IE General Office to sign to confirm acceptance of the transfer between 7 July and 13 July 2026. The Department will submit all approved application forms to RES on 14 July 2026.
